STARTING MAY 7, 2018

All firefighters, regardless of rank or position, have one thing in common, we will retire some day. Yet, in contrast with the intensive and extensive training firefighters receive in our careers, often there is no training or preplanning for life after the fire service. Separation from service can have an extreme effect on our members. Those effects may be even more prominent when our members are forced to retire due to a disability.

The <u>RISAFF Members' Assistance Program</u> has partnered with Clinical Services of RI to provide a *CONFIDENTIAL* resource for those members who have separated from service and have found it difficult to move forward in their lives. CSRI has offered *3 Locations* for our members *weekly*, and *3 days during the week*, *starting May 7, 2018*.
